Proposal Strengths:
 Overall, the application was well explained and contained detailed information. The data provided shows the need, as well as how 21CCLC will address the needs within the community. There is a well-developed evaluation plan which should serve to assist the school district and the Boy and Girls Club with program improvement information by which to plan and improve programming. MSD Warren Township presented a reasonable proposal for after school and summer programming for students grades K-4th and 5-8th focusing on STEM. Several sections of the proposals presented only partial/limited information thus resulting in a reduction of points. Application lost majority of points in the program design, program implementation and Safety/transportation sections of application. Proposal could be strengthened by more incorporation of evidenced based data in addition to more thoughtful safety processes.
Proposal Weaknesses:
 No major weaknesses. Application was for the most part well organized.

 It is not clear why Warren Township Schools indicate this program is a "for profit" enterprise (program income is marked "yes") as the application gives no information about charging for costs for the programming. (There is some indication of a fee of \$15.00 which will be charged at the local Boys and Girls Club site off-site of the Warren Township schools in the Program Stability section.)
