- Presented a cohesive proposal. Many sections were well developed.
- Several novel strategies are implemented, including a focus on hiring parents, the use of the Parapro exam, and the efforts to integrate communication with teachers and parents.
- Existing partnerships. Partnership with Trine to engage volunteers and work-study students.

Proposal Weaknesses:

- Some data was missing from this proposal. Could be strengthened by adding more
 detail in sections and being clearer on how proposed activities align with the goal of the
 proposal.
- A few sections could have benefitted from greater detail, including the schedule, the Enhance or Expand section and the list of outcomes in the project abstract.
- Program Space agreement is not included in the MOU's. Comparing local data to start rates could help demonstrate need.
