The following schools are not currently included in the SY20-21 Title I Planning Allocation and therefore are not included in the planning allocations for ESSER II. Using discretionary CRRSA funds, the IDOE is setting aside a minimum of \$40,000 per school to support emergency COVID response and support student needs. Each school's allocation may increase based on the final SY20-21 Title I allocations; however, each school will receive no less than \$40,000.

The following schools are new charter schools scheduled to open in SY21-22. These schools are not included in the SY20-21 Title I allocations, and are therefore ineligible to receive formulaic ESSER funds. As a result, the IDOE is setting aside discretionary funds to ensure each school has resources to support students to overcome the challenges of COVID 19 when they arrive next school year.
