DEFINITION	CHARACTERISTICS
<p>Activities that are designed to build parents' capacity to support their child's academic experience in school.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Focuses on academic skills and skills needed for school.</li> <li>- On-going and accommodates all parents</li> <li>- Held at a convenient time for parents</li> <li>- Parents have an equal voice in the planning and design in shaping school parent involvement policy and activities.</li> <li>- Held in various times and places, such as meeting on weekends at a community center.</li> </ul>
