OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY STANDARDS COMMISSION Adoption by Reference Bulletin #24-02

IC 22-8-1.1-16.2 provides that a United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standard lawfully adopted by OSHA under federal law may be enforced by the Indiana Department of Labor (IDOL) not earlier than sixty (60) days after the final standard by federal OSHA becomes effective. The Indiana Occupational Safety Standards Commission (IOSSC) shall publish a statement describing such a standard and making reference to the federal regulation. When adopted by the IDOL, the statement must be published under IC 4-22-7-7(b).

The Indiana Department of Labor adopts and incorporates by reference the OSHA standards in 29 CFR Part 1910 Hazard Communication Standard, published originally in the Federal Register, October 9, 2024, Volume 89, pages 81829 through 81836.

Federal effective date: October 9, 2024

Indiana effective date: April 9, 2025
