Reminders

Renewals for Yard Tractor Permits and Plates were mailed May 14, 2004. These renewals were due in our office on or before June 13, 2004. If your renewal was received after June 13, 2004, you may not have your credentials before the expiration date of June 30, 2004.

Effective July 1, 2004, converter dollies used with a semi-trailer will not be charged any registration fees according to IC 9-18-9-4.

Fuel Tax Update

Renewals for International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) or Intrastate Motor Carrier Fuel Tax were mailed June 15, 2004. These are due back in our office on or before September 1, 2004.

We will begin mailing license cards and decals on November 15, 2004. Our goal is to provide you with ample time to place the license card and decal in your vehicle(s) on or before January 1, 2005.

IFTA Carriers

Effective May 1, 2004, Manitoba (MB), Canada, has a split rate for diesel fuel for the second quarter of 2004. The IFTA-101 will have two MB lines. If you operated in Manitoba May 1, 2004 through June 30, 2004, you will enter the total miles and total gallons on the first (1st) detail line. If you operated in Manitoba from April 1, 2004 through April 30, 2004, you will enter the total miles and total gallons on the second (2nd) detail line.
