Biography

Mr. Hubbard co-founded E&A Industries, Inc. in 1977 and, except during his Government service, has served as its Chairman. E&A has owned a number of companies in different industries and currently owns companies involved in light fixtures, medical equipment and women’s apparel.

Hubbard has served in the White House under two different administrations. During the George H. W. Bush administration, Hubbard was Deputy Chief of Staff to Vice President Dan Quayle and Executive Director of the President’s Council on Competitiveness. During the George W. Bush Administration, Hubbard was Assistant to the President for Economic Policy and Director of National Economic Council.

Hubbard has also served on a number of for-profit and not-for-profit boards including WellPoint Corporation, Simon Property Group, and PIMCO Equity Series & PIMCO Equity Series VIT. Hubbard is a member of Council on Foreign Relations.

Hubbard earned his J.D., cum laude, from Harvard Law School, his MBA with Distinction from Harvard Business School, and his B.A., cum laude, from Vanderbilt University. Hubbard and his wife, Kathy, reside in Indianapolis and have three children ages 27, 25 and 25.
