Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Office of Small Business and Entrepreneurship (“OSBE”) has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes contained in LSA Document 14-109 proposed by the Indiana Department of Revenue (IDOR). The proposed rule repeals 45 IAC 20-1-1, 45 IAC 20-1-2, 45 IAC 20-1-3, 45 IAC 20-1-4, 45 IAC 20-1-5, 45 IAC 20-1-6, and 45 IAC 20-1-7 concerning quality assessment on health facilities.

The economic impact statement prepared by the IDOR indicates there is no economic impact on small businesses.
