RE: Legislative Changes due to House Enrolled Act 1002-2017

Dear Valued Motor Carrier:

During this year's legislative session, the Indiana General Assembly enacted House Enrolled Act ("HEA") 1002, which impacts your industry. Accordingly, in our mission to serve you as effectively as possible, we wanted to proactively provide to you a high-level summary of some legislative changes that may impact your business operations.

HEA 1002 created new supplemental registration fees for hybrid and electric vehicles. These new fees apply to registrations of all hybrid and electric vehicles and will be due and payable each year during the registration renewal process. The supplemental registration fee for hybrid vehicles is \$50 per vehicle, while the supplemental registration fee for electric vehicles is \$150 per vehicle. The collection of these new supplemental registration fees will begin on January 1st, 2018.

Additionally, HEA 1002 created the Transportation Infrastructure Improvement ("TII") Fee, which is applicable to certain categories of motor vehicles. The TII Fee is also due and payable each year during the registration renewal process and is \$15 per vehicle. As with the supplemental hybrid and electric vehicle registration fees, the collection of the TII Fee will begin on January 1st, 2018.

Further, HEA 1002 reduced the population requirements relating to cities imposing a Wheel Tax. Specifically, the required population for a city to impose a Wheel Tax was reduced from 10,000 to 5,000 residents. As a result, it is expected that an increased number of municipalities will impose a Wheel Tax.
