RE: Legislative Changes due to House Enrolled Act 1301-2018

Dear Valued Motor Carrier:

During this year's legislative session, the Indiana General Assembly enacted House Enrolled Act (HEA) 1301, which impacts your industry.

This new law changes your insurance requirements. Beginning July 1, 2018, the minimum level of financial responsibility required for contract carriers that transport railroad employees will be at least \$5 million in insurance.

If this applies to you, you will need to:

- notify your insurance company by July 1, 2018 to obtain the new level of insurance,
- ask your insurance company to provide a Form E (MC 2401) to the Department, and
- send the Department a new contract with the increased coverage by July 1, 2018.
