

**NOTICE TO OUT-OF-STATE CORPORATIONS
APPLYING FOR INDIANA PRIVATE
EMPLOYMENT AGENCY LICENSE**

Secretary of State Approval

Indiana Code 23-1-17-4 requires that all foreign (out-of-state) corporations must be registered with the Indiana Secretary of State in order to do business in the State of Indiana. This requirement applies only to out-of-state corporations and not to any other business entity.

Failure to register with the Secretary of State's office may result in your application for a Private Employment Agency license to be rejected.

All out-of-state corporations must complete the following section or your application for a license may be denied.
