Is it the intent of the SOQ that any and all consultants utilized to satisfy the Additional INDOT Consultant Prequalification Categories listed in Part A, Section 2.1.3 be considered as "Major Participants" regardless of whether they perform less than 30% of the design work?	Please see revisions to <u>Part A, Section 8.4.1</u> and <u>Part B, Section 2</u> of the RFQ. Proposer teams are required to meet the pre-qualification categories outlined in <u>Part A, Section 2.1.3 (a), (b) and (c)</u> in order to be determined a Qualified Proposer.
3	Contractor A, L.P. (Proposer) is a limited partner and Contractor AB, Inc. is the general partner. Contractor AB does not play an active role within Contractor A's company on projects and/or company structure. Is Contractor A required to complete the B-2 and C form for Contractor AB in its SOQ since Contractor A and Contractor AB are not creating a partnership for this project nor operate its businesses in a partnering manor in day to day business?	Yes. All Proposers must comply with <u>Part B, Section 4.1</u> and "Provide executed originals of <b>Form B-2</b> and <b>Form C</b> for Proposer, each Major Participant and each guarantor."
