



SUMMARY OF APPROACH TO PARTNERING WITH INDOT IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PIP

Partnering

The Design-Build Team's approach is to integrate the core values of each organization and collaborate seamlessly to achieve cooperation, dynamic creativity, and efficient use of resources. Partnering is an essential aspect of our culture and is embraced on all levels. We will hold a partnering kick-off meeting upon receipt of notice to proceed (NTP) to continue this collaborative environment.

As a significant artery for Indianapolis, the North Split project serves a variety of motorists, including substantial freight traffic, local, and regional commuters. A comprehensive public information plan (PIP) is critical to keeping travelers aware of upcoming traffic shifts and lane closures. We will utilize the partnering process, engaging all stakeholders to keep them updated and informed. And we will coordinate our traffic management plan (TMP) with crucial stakeholders and accommodate unique local events.

SUMMARY OF APPROACH TO ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVITY, SAFETY, TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT, AND CONSTRUCTION STAGING

Environmental Sensitivity

The Design-Build Team will draft a project-specific environmental compliance and mitigation plan. The plan will identify key personnel as well as outline the necessary environmental-related procedures, documentation, and mitigation of non-compliant issues.

During final design, we will obtain all required environmental permits. As environmental compliance manager (ECM), Michele Meyer will manage the permitting process and will keep a log of all permit types, requirements, durations, and status. We will implement and identify any environmentally sensitive items, including environmental boundaries, erosion prevention, wetland / wildlife identification, waterways, cultural resources, and floodplains during final design development. In construction, we will implement plans for:

We will carefully approach all environmental concerns. We are fully committed to avoiding and minimizing impacts to wetlands and other environmentally sensitive areas.

AVOIDING & MINIMIZING IMPACTS

While working on the Indianapolis Airport Interchange on I-70 project completed with INDOT, team members were involved in relocating 12,000 LF of highly sensitive creek at the Ronald Reagan Interchange. This experience demonstrates direct collaboration and in-depth knowledge with both INDOT and the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM).

Safety

The Design-Build Team will strive to meet **OUR GOAL OF ZERO INCIDENTS** on the North Split project. Bobby Greer, safety manager, will oversee all safety processes to safeguard the health and safety of each employee, subcontractor, stakeholder, and the traveling public. He will ensure that all team members are trained and certified in the required INDOT, Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) safety protocols.

COMMITMENT TO SAFETY

A key component to our safety strategy is our Task Hazard Analysis (THA). These guide daily meetings that detail tasks to be performed. It's an opportunity for all team members to identify and discuss potential risks and hazards, as well as mitigation plans.

Traffic Management

We identified numerous solutions to minimize cost and reduce lane closure durations before any significant movement closures. In critical work zones, we will use temporary traffic barriers to provide the safest environment for workers and motorists. Highlights include:

- Maintain two travel lanes for the four required open movements during the major movement closures
- Use signage to guide drivers to detour onto I-465 away from the construction zone
- Ensure continuous emergency access

Our TMP will address traffic within the project limits and mobility throughout the corridor with plans for temporary traffic control, transportation operations, and public information. We will coordinate with surrounding projects and agencies, including INDOT, the City of Indianapolis, Marion County, emergency services, and the Indiana State Police. Coordination efforts will be paramount to ensuring the TMP developed provides a unified approach during construction, avoids delays at project interfaces, and maximizes mobility. We will utilize our experienced professionals to design, implement, and maintain a traffic control plan that will minimize construction impacts and maximize the traveler experience.

Construction Staging

Construction staging is planned to minimize impacts to motorists and the surrounding communities. To limit the number of traffic phases, our sequencing plan implements four larger areas:

- Interchange
- West leg
- East leg
- South leg

We sequenced the phases between the four areas to provide optimal construction and traffic flow efficiency by starting the east leg and offline interchange work scopes in early work packages before any movement closures. Phasing within each area was designed to maximize the amount of work completed during each traffic phase to minimize the impact on the traveling public.

SUMMARY OF APPROACH TO SATISFYING APPLICABLE DBE REQUIREMENTS

The Design-Build Team will continue our long history supporting the disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE) communities. As part of our shared commitment, we developed a preliminary DBE plan that included multiple project-focused outreach events. Our plan will continue to engage participants through procurement and

multiple bidding opportunities, incorporate best practices, mentoring programs, and technical assistance. The DBE plan will be finalized to maximize DBE participation.

SUMMARY OF INNOVATIVE CONCEPTS AND APPROVED ATCs

The Design-Build Team developed 14 alternatives to achieve INDOT's project goals. Figure 5 outlines our approved Alternative Technical Concepts (ATCs) that both enhance design and provide long-term safety and life-cycle maintenance benefits.

SUMMARY APPROACH FOR WORKING WITH INDOT AND THIRD PARTIES, INCLUDING RESOLVING CONFLICTS

It is our belief that **COMMUNICATION** and **PARTNERING** are key to any project's success. Our approach promotes conflict resolution at the lowest level possible before being escalated. To ensure that the North Split project is performed seamlessly and cost effectively, Tim will employ the methods described in our PMP.

SUMMARY OF CONCEPTUAL PROJECT SCHEDULE, SCHEDULED MOVEMENT CLOSURE DURATIONS, ANTICIPATED MILESTONES


We included a detailed preliminary baseline schedule in a Volume 2 Appendix. We are committed to delivering substantial completion after 905 days of issuance of NTP. We are also committed to completing the following movements ahead of the proposed movement closure durations:

- I-65 northbound to I-70 eastbound 40 days
- I-65 northbound to I-65 northbound 40 days
- I-70 westbound to I-70 westbound 44 days

CONCLUSION




Figure 8. Relationship Between Proposer, Equity Members, Any Guarantors, and Financially Responsible Parties
