



Description: The original plans and specifications for the Project required Superior to utilize HE-IV Elliptical pipe underneath a fill area on the project which would be covered by approximately 25 feet of embankment. Unfortunately, the type and grade of elliptical pipe prescribed within the original plans and specifications was not adequate to withstand the amount of stress that the earthen fill would place impose upon the pipe. After the original work was completed, the elliptical pipe began to show signs of failure due to stress cracking in the top of the pipe. As a result, Superior was directed to perform corrective work to remove and replace the failing elliptical pipe. While Superior was contractually responsible to perform this work, it investigated the possible causes of the failure and determined that the pipe was under-designed and was not suitable for installation in this deep of an application without taking measures to reduce the amount of pressure that would be placed on the pipe. As a result of its investigation, Superior notified INDOT that while it would perform any work demanded by INDOT, any such work would be additional work; and Superior would be entitled to both additional time and compensation to complete the corrective work.
