SUBJECT: Extended Inspection Frequency

REVISION: INDOT Bridge Inspection Manual 2-2.06(04)

EFFECTIVE: Immediately

Part 2: Types of Inspections of the INDOT Bridge Inspection Manual has been updated as follows.

2-2.06(04) Extended Inspection Frequency

Section 2-2.06(04) is suspended in its entirety until further notice.

INDOT is no longer accepting requests to place any bridges on an extended inspection frequency. However, bridges that are currently on an extended inspection frequency may remain on such inspection frequency under the following requirements:

1. All provisions of the extended frequency screening criteria continue to remain satisfied following each scheduled inspection.
2. Documentation verifying that all required screening criteria are satisfied is submitted to, and approved by, the State Bridge Inspection Program Manager following each scheduled inspection.

Bridges currently approved for extended inspection frequencies that no longer satisfy all of the extended frequency screening provisions shall no longer be permitted to retain an extended inspection frequency.
