Distressed Unit Appeal Board Meeting to be Held on Tuesday, July 25

INDIANAPOLIS (July 21, 2017) – The Distressed Unit Appeal Board (“DUAB”) will hold a public meeting at the Teleconference Media Center, Indiana Government Center South Building, 402 W. Washington Street, Indianapolis, at 9:00 a.m. Eastern on Tuesday, July 25, 2017. At the meeting, DUAB will review a proposed contract for transportation services for Gary Community School Corporation. In addition, DUAB will hold a discussion of criteria to be considered when appointing the emergency manager for Gary Community School Corporation. The appointment of the emergency manager is anticipated to occur at the end of July.

During the period between the signing of Senate Enrolled Act 567 and the appointment of an emergency manager for Gary Community School Corporation, DUAB is required to approve of a contract prior to the Gary Community School Corporation’s School Board taking action on the contract.
