Distressed Unit Appeal Board to Hold Meeting on December 13

INDIANAPOLIS (December 11, 2017) – The Distressed Unit Appeal Board (“DUAB”) will hold a meeting in Indianapolis at 1:30 p.m. Eastern on December 13, 2017. The meeting will be held in the Ways and Means Committee Room, Room 404, at the Indiana Statehouse, 200 W. Washington Street, Indianapolis. During the meeting, DUAB is expected to make its determination on whether to designate Muncie Community Schools as a distressed political subdivision. This determination is being made pursuant to [Indiana Code 6-1.1-20.3-7.1](#) (<http://iga.in.gov/legislative/laws/2017/ic/titles/006#6-1.1-20.3-7.1>).

In addition, DUAB will also consider a request from the emergency manager for Gary Community School Corporation to determine the compensation for a chief financial officer, pursuant to [Indiana Code 6-1.1-20.3-6.8](#) (<http://iga.in.gov/legislative/laws/2017/ic/titles/006#6-1.1-20.3-6.8>).
