## **DISTRESSED UNIT APPEAL BOARD EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT JUNE 4, 2018**

The purpose of this report is to provide an update on the emergency management of Gary Community School Corporation and Muncie Community Schools and actions of the Distressed Unit Appeal Board (“DUAB”) executive director since the last Executive Director’s Report on May 4, 2018. The information below should not be considered complete documentation of all actions taken by the emergency managers, as the statements below highlight only specific actions taken by the emergency managers and meetings held in the timeframe covered by this report.

### Gary Community School Corporation (“GCSC”)

- The emergency management team held a community meeting on May 17 to discuss the master facilities plan.
- The emergency management team has participated in a number of local community events including events hosted by the Urban League, Gary Chamber of Commerce and the NAACP.
- Contract Approvals Pursuant to DUAB Resolution 2017-1:
  - Vibe HCM, Inc. Payroll Software and Processing Services - \$238,237 for a two-year term
  - Bloomington Ford - \$105,815.67 for three security vehicles
  - PowerSchool ERP Software System - \$125,678.77 for a three-year term

### Muncie Community Schools (“MCS”)

- On May 16, the Ball State Board of Trustees adopted a resolution to serve as the appointing authority for MCS’ governing body, effective July 1, 2018.
- The emergency management team has been holding weekly meetings with Ball State officials to assist in the transition. In addition, specific meetings are being held as needed, such as a planning meeting for facilities.
- Contract Approvals Pursuant to DUAB Resolution 2017-1:
  - ClaimAid Consulting Group Medicaid-Eligible Billing Services - \$59,000 for a three-year term
