

RESOLUTION 2018-1

**RESOLUTION OF THE DISTRESSED UNIT APPEAL BOARD TERMINATING
MUNCIE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS' STATUS AS A DISTRESSED POLITICAL
SUBDIVISION UNDER IC 6-1.1-20.3**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code ("IC") 6-1.1-20.3-4 establishes the Distressed Unit Appeal Board ("DUAB"); and

WHEREAS, under the authority of IC 6-1.1-20.3-7.1 (2017), DUAB designated Muncie Community Schools ("School Corporation") as a distressed political subdivision on December 13, 2017, through DUAB Resolution 2017-3; and

WHEREAS, House Enrolled Act 1315(ss) was signed into law on May 14, 2018; and

WHEREAS, House Enrolled Act 1315(ss) creates a new chapter of Indiana Code, IC 20-23-18, which was effective upon passage; and

WHEREAS, IC 20-23-18-1 allows the Ball State University Board of Trustees ("BSU Board") to adopt a resolution by June 1, 2018, to take advantage of the relationship between Ball State University and the School Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the BSU Board adopted such resolution on May 16, 2018; and

WHEREAS, IC 20-23-18-4 states that DUAB shall terminate the School Corporation's designation as a distressed political subdivision by July 1, 2018, if the BSU Board adopts such resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Distressed Unit Appeal Board hereby terminates Muncie Community Schools' designation as a distressed political subdivision, effective July 1, 2018.

Adopted by the Distressed Unit Appeal Board on June 4, 2018, by vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.
