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Distressed Unit Appeal Board Meeting Memorandum

June 15, 2017

Call to Order: A meeting of the Distressed Unit Appeals Board (DUAB or Board) was held on June 15, 2017, at 5:30 p.m. at the Southside Middle School, Auditorium, 1601 East 26th Street, Muncie, Indiana. Members of the Board attending the meeting include Micah Vincent, Chairman, Kent Hatcher, Paul Joyce, Courtney Schaafsma, and Rep. Milo Smith.

Chairman Vincent began the meeting by having the Board introduce themselves. He then stated that the purpose of the meeting is to hold presentations from those that applied for the emergency manager position for Muncie Community Schools (MCS).

Chairman Vincent then gave preliminary remarks regarding the presentations and described the procedure for the presentations. He then said that Dr. Baule was not asked to provide a presentation because he already introduced his deficit reduction plan at the May 1, 2017 meeting, therefore his absence should not be construed as showing a lack of interest in the emergency manager position. He also said that another candidate, the Robert Bobb Group, had applied but was unable to make the meeting.
