Distressed Unit Appeal Board to Hold Meeting on April 26

INDIANAPOLIS (April 22, 2022) – The Distressed Unit Appeal Board (“DUAB”) will hold a meeting at 1:30 pm Eastern Daylight Time on Tuesday, April 26, 2022. During the meeting, the Gary Community School Corporation (“GCSC”) Manager will provide an update and review its accountability dashboard. The board will also consider the purchase of classroom security locks, activity buses, roof restoration, and ViewSonic boards for the school district.

The meeting will be held in-person at the Indiana Government Center South, Conference Room D, 302 W. Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204. The meeting will also be broadcast via WebEx.
