Distressed Unit Appeal Board to Hold Meeting on March 28

INDIANAPOLIS (March 22, 2022) – The Distressed Unit Appeal Board (“DUAB”) will hold a meeting at 1:00 pm Eastern Daylight Time on Monday, March 28, 2022. During the meeting, the Gary Community School Corporation (“GCSC”) Manager will provide an update on its deficit reduction efforts. Plans for improving academics and spending ESSER III funds will be presented. The board will also consider the purchase of student laptops as well as capital improvements to West Side Leadership Academy, Bailly STEM Academy, Beveridge Elementary, and Glen Park Academy.

The meeting will be held in-person at the **One North Capitol** building (1 N. Capitol Avenue, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204) in the First Floor Conference Room. The meeting will also be broadcast via WebEx. At the start of the meeting, DUAB will take public comment. Comments should be kept to 3 minutes maximum.
