Distressed Unit Appeal Board to Meet February 23

INDIANAPOLIS (February 21, 2023) – The Distressed Unit Appeal Board (“DUAB”) will hold a public meeting at 1:30 pm Eastern Standard Time on Thursday, February 23, 2023. During the meeting, the board will receive operations, financial, and academic updates regarding the Gary Community School Corporation (“GCSC”), including a review of mid-year i-Ready results. The board will also consider the purchase of a new chiller system at West Side Leadership Academy.

The meeting will be held in-person at the Indiana Government Center South, Conference Rooms 4 & 5 (Wabash Hall), 302 W. Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.
