


Average Daily Attendance








Tutor Consistency

Literacy Cadre Overview

GCSC joined the literacy cadre in in the **2022-23** school year. All **5 elementary schools** are participating this school year, and we have opted in for the 2024-25 school year as well.

Participating schools receive:

- Comprehensive support for leadership and instructional coaches to align instruction with science of reading.
- Onsite and virtual support from a dedicated Literacy Training Support Specialist (TSS) from an Education Service Center (ESC) for the Cadre coach and administration in the implementation of the Cadre goals.
- Financial support for an approved school-based Literacy Cadre coach (% for first year and then 1/3 for second year).
- Summer training focused on science of reading and instructional coaching practice.
- Additional training and support in ongoing, bi-monthly virtual Collaboration Network meetings.
- Supplemental curricular materials based on district needs.
- Ongoing support and assistance in aligning instruction with science of reading.

Participating schools agree to:

- Apply for the IDOE Formative Assessment Grant to offset cost associated with using an approved formative assessment tool.
- Submit a Literacy Cadre coach for approval by IDOE.
- Engage in regular professional development throughout the year.
- Align instructional practices with science of reading through coaching partnerships.
- Administer Indiana-approved formative assessment tools during two-year cadre participation.
- Administer IREAD-3 at grade two.
- Protect your coach's time to ensure they can effectively support teachers.
- Share data for the purposes of research, progress monitoring, and program evaluation.



Family & Community Engagement Plan

In December 2023, GCSC was awarded a statewide family engagement grant through INSource, in the amount of \$100,000 per year for 5 years to bolster our family & community engagement strategy and implement a research-based framework for family-school partnerships.

WELCOMING CULTURE

Goal: Ensure that the culture of our schools feels warm & welcoming to family and community members.

- Engage Communications Liaisons to assist in sharing information with families

WORKING TOGETHER

Goal: Collaborate with family and community stakeholders to create and implement an action plan to improve attendance.

Activities:

- Increase districtwide staffing to support attendance
- Implement wellness checks for students with 10+ absences
- Collaborate with families to identify and address common barriers to attendance
- Host regular sessions for families to receive counseling and support for student attendance

LEARNING TOGETHER

Goal: Collaborate with family and community stakeholders to ensure that all GCSC students can read on grade-level.

Activities:

- Host monthly Roar for Reading events with book giveaways
- Collaborate with the Reading League Indiana to share information about the Science of Reading
- Expand literacy events to embed in community spaces
- Share resources for families to teach their children to read at home
