Statement of Need for Indiana Disabled Hoosier Veteran License Plate Under Indiana Code 9-18.5-5

Dear Veteran:

The Disabled Hoosier Veteran License Plate is considered a handicap plate which requires that the VA rated service-connected disability must cause pain or difficulty when walking. Your **VA Rated SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY** is not one which we can readily identify as one which would cause the requisite pain or difficulty when walking.

Please ask your VA physician to complete this form attesting to your need for this license plate due to pain or difficulty walking due to your **SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY**. Upon completion of this form, send it with the license plate application to our office. You may mail the form, fax it, or hand-carry it to our office.
