# Wayne County Veteran Community Drive-Through Food Pantry

The Wayne County Veterans Drive-Through Food Pantry, a vital resource for local veterans, has reached a significant milestone, celebrating five years of service. Launched during the pandemic, this initiative was spearheaded by Al Bledsoe, a prominent veteran advocate in Richmond. With sponsorship from Cronin Toyota and food supplies from Circle U, the pantry quickly grew beyond its initial capacity. Cronin Toyota provided essential space for storage and staging, while VFW Post 1108 generously offered their parking lot for distribution and contributed funds for meat options in each food box. The pantry operates with a seamless efficiency, thanks to a dedicated team of veterans who manage the logistics with warmth and camaraderie. Originally serving 20–30 vehicles, the pantry's popularity necessitated a move to the Richmond VA Community Based Outpatient Clinic, where it currently serves an average of 120 veterans per session. With its continued success, the pantry will now relocate to a larger, permanent home at Glenn Miller Park in Richmond, ensuring it can meet the growing demand and continue to support the veteran community effectively.




