Eligible Wartime Service dates for VA Purposes:

- World War II (December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946)
- Korean conflict (June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955)
- Vietnam era (February 28, 1961 – May 7, 1975 for Veterans who served in the Republic of Vietnam during that period; otherwise August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975)
- Gulf War (August 2, 1990 – through a future date to be set by law or Presidential Proclamation)

NOTE: IDVA does not have Armed Forces reserve component discharges on file nor do information requests we send to the VA Regional office return any record of Reserve Component or National Guard service. These must be provided to us by the veteran.
