Disabled Veteran Property Tax Credit Applicant,

Your application for the Disabled Veterans Property Tax Credit has been received. We are unable to approve the eligibility of your application for the following reason/s:

No record of a 10% or greater service-connected disability rating on file at The United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

No record of the Veteran serving during a period of Wartime: USDVA Shows service dates from: to:

You will not be eligible until after you turn 62 years of age with your current service-connected rating of %

No record of the Veteran receiving a non-service-connected pension is on file at Federal Department of Veterans Affairs.

The individual served in the military or naval forces of the United States for less than 90 days.

There has not been a determination for your service-connected disability claim to date.

Veteran's DD214 does not show an Honorable discharge as required by Indiana Code 6-1.1-12

Eligible Wartime Service dates for VA Purposes:

- World War II (December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946)
- Korean conflict (June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955)
- Vietnam era (February 28, 1961 – May 7, 1975 for Veterans who served in the Republic of Vietnam during that period; otherwise August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975)
- Gulf War (August 2, 1990 – through a future date to be set by law or Presidential Proclamation)

NOTE: IDVA does not have Armed Forces reserve component discharges on file nor do information requests we send to the VA Regional office return any record of Reserve Component or National Guard service. These must be provided to us by the Veteran.
