PURPOSE OF NOTICE

The Department of Workforce Development (department) is soliciting public comment on adding a rule at <u>646 IAC 5-14</u> concerning the processing fee charged by the department for last known employer (LKE) records. The department seeks comment on the affected citations listed and any other provisions of Title 646 that may be affected by this rulemaking.

OVERVIEW

Basic Purpose and Background

House Enrolled Act 1623-2023 (HEA 1623) established new requirements for executive agency rulemaking and provided a safe harbor for executive agencies to come into compliance with Indiana Code regarding fees, fines, and civil penalties set by the agency. This proposed rule is being promulgated to comply with HEA 1623.

Processing fees charged by the department for LKE records are set forth in statute. Under IC 22-4-19-6(k), under certain circumstances, the department may charge a processing fee not to exceed two dollars (\$2) for each record that provides information about an individual's LKE. The department currently charges a two dollar (\$2) processing fee for each LKE record. The proposed rule specifies the dollar amount of the current LKE record processing fee assessed by the department. This rule will be added to 646 IAC 5 and does not change the amount of the fee currently charged by the department.

PROPOSED RULE

SECTION 1. 646 IAC 5-14 IS ADDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Rule 14. Last Known Employer Information

646 IAC 5-14-1 Processing fee for last known employer records

Authority: <u>IC 22-4-19-1</u> Affected: IC 22-4-19-6

Sec. 1. The department will charge a processing fee of two dollars (\$2) for each record that provides information about an individual's last known employer in compliance with a court order under IC 22-4-19-6(k).
