<sup>3</sup> The Attorney General’s Office has 45 days from the date that DWD submits or resubmits its rule to review pursuant to IC § 4-22-2-32.

<sup>4</sup> The Governor has 15 days from the date DWD submits its rule to approve or disapprove the rule. However, the Governor may take 30 days to approve or disapprove the rule if the Governor files a statement with the Publisher within the first 15 days after the rule is submitted that states the Government intends to take an additional 15 days to review the rule pursuant to IC § 4-22-2-34.

<sup>5</sup> A rule becomes effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher pursuant to IC § 4-22-2-36.
