Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.3 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 6th in the U.S.
- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 0.6 percentage points over the year, which ranks 22nd in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 43 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.6% vs. 62.7% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 24,400 over the year.
