

September 2017 Beyond the Numbers...

Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 6.9 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 8th in the U.S.
- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 0.5 percentage points over the year, which ranks 23rd in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 40 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.5% vs. 63.1% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs has grown 24,900 over the year.
- Weekly initial unemployment insurance claims and regular unemployment insurance claims continue to be at their lowest point in more than three decades.
