

April 2021 Beyond the Numbers...

Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 13.0 percentage points since April 2020 (the **new** low point of employment), which ranks 5th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 111,886 over the year and is at 3,336,918.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 13 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.1% vs. 61.7% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have increased by 362,400 over the year.

Private Education and Health Services Growth

- Indiana ranks 10th in the nation in Private Education and Health Services jobs added over the month.
