Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 12.8 percentage points since April 2020 which ranks 5th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 22,801 over the year and is at 3,343,658.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 17 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.1% vs. 61.7% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have increased by 72,700 over the year.

Private Education and Health Services Growth

- Indiana ranks 10th in the nation in Private Education and Health Services jobs added over the month.
