Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 14.2 percentage points since April 2020 which ranks 4th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has decreased by 32,609 over the year and is at 3,311,320.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 21 consecutive months. Indiana's rate is currently 62.4% vs. 61.9% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have increased by 82,400 over the year.
