

February 2021 Beyond the Numbers...

Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 12.9 percentage points since April 2020 (the **new** low point of employment), which ranks 3rd in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has decreased by 16,321 over the year and is at 3,342,839.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 11 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.2% vs. 61.4% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have decreased by 113,400 over the year.

Trade, Transportation and Utilities Growth

- **Indiana ranks 10th in the nation in Trade, Transportation and Utilities job growth over the year.**
