Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 12.8 percentage points since April 2020 which ranks 5th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 41,694 over the year and is at 3,346,060.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 16 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.2% vs. 61.7% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have increased by 96,600 over the year.
