- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 12.9 percentage points since April 2020 (the **new** low point of employment), which ranks 5th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 78,751 over the year and is at 3,343,498.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 14 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.2% vs. 61.6% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have increased by 234,800 over the year.
