

# November 2021 Beyond the Numbers...

## *Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report*

---

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 13.9 percentage points since April 2020 which ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 21,182 over the year and is at 3,319,801.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 20 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 62.5% vs. 61.8% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have increased by 78,200 over the year.
