

# September 2021 Beyond the Numbers...

*Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report*

---

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 12.9 percentage points since April 2020 which ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 9,716 over the year and is at 3,341,532.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 18 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.0% vs. 61.6% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have increased by 63,500 over the year.
