

Re: End of Contract Notice


To Whom It May Concern:

CBI Services, LLC ("CB&I") received notice that Suncoke Energy has elected not to renew its contract with CB&I to perform maintenance services for Suncoke here at the Suncoke Indiana Harbor facility. The contract expires on March 6, 2017. Unfortunately, this decision by Suncoke adversely affects employment with CB&I for all current employees at this location. This decision affects 149 employees

The name and address of the employment site where this layoff will occur is 3210 Watling Street, East Chicago, IN, 46312. The layoffs associated with the end of this contract are expected to be permanent, affecting all CB&I employees at the site, and there are no bumping rights associated with the layoff.

We are working closely with Suncoke to ensure a smooth transition. Part of that will absolutely include trying to confirm that Suncoke hires as many of our employees as possible. Those employees left without a position with Suncoke or the new contractor are free to apply for any job with CB&I anywhere we have a worksite.
