

Subject: WARN Act Notice

This letter is to advise you that a layoff will take place at the Indianapolis Plant located at 6900 East English Avenue, Indianapolis, IN.

It is anticipated that approximately 91 hourly employees will be affected by the layoff on or about December 19, 2011. This layoff will be permanent. The Indianapolis Plant is scheduled for closure during the first half of 2012. As a result, additional layoffs will occur, with all hourly personnel working at that location slated for layoff on or before May of 2012. The number of affected employees by classification as outlined in this letter may be less due to the anticipation of potential attrition e.g., transfers, voluntary quits, retirements, etc., between now and the effective date of this action.

The classifications and the associated number of affected employees presently occupying these classifications are as follows:
