

January 2017 Beyond the Numbers...

Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 6.7 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 4th in the U.S.
- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 0.7 percentage points over the year, which ranks 5th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 32 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.2% vs. 62.9% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs is now 58,400 above the March 2000 peak employment levels.
- Weekly initial unemployment insurance claims and regular unemployment insurance claims are at their lowest point in over three decades.
