RE: Kellogg Seelyville Bakery; Notice of permanent layoffs/Plant closure

Dear Ms. Long:

As announced in August of 2016, due to capacity constraints in its cracker network, Kellogg Company will be closing the Seelyville Bakery located at 9445 E. US Hwy 40 Terre Haute, IN 47805 and permanently laying off employees at that bakery.

The Company expects to permanently lay off 92 employees. The anticipated schedule of layoffs is as follows:

Number of Employees	Anticipated Date of Layoff
83	14 Day Period From 8/13/17 to 8/26/17
9	14 Day Period From 9/3/17 to 9/23/17

Employees at the Seelyville bakery are not represented by a union; affected employees do not have bumping rights.

The Company will maintain a list of the positions to be affected and the number of employees in each job classification for inspection upon request.
