

MDwise met with the Indiana Family and Social Services Agency, Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP), to discuss the capitation rates for the Indiana Hoosier Care Connect program. Unfortunately, MDwise was unable to secure rates needed to continue its participation in the program.


Thus, MDwise will not sign a 2017 Hoosier Care Connect contract and our current contract will expire at the end of March, 2017. We are hopeful that other employers will provide MDwise employees opportunities for employment as our MDwise Hoosier Care Connect beneficiaries are transitioned to two other employers. However, we do not know at this time the plans such other employers have with respect to employment of MDwise employees. Accordingly, pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN"), we regret to inform you that MDwise will on April 17, 2017, terminate the employment of employees at its Madison Plaza facility (the "Madison Plaza facility") located at 1200 Madison Avenue, Indianapolis, Indiana 46225 due to the loss of the Hoosier Care Connect program (many of whom recently moved to the Fortune Circle facility and who are noted in the accompanying notice regarding that facility). Although other areas of the Madison Plaza facility will remain in operation, after completing transition and runout services, the entire Hoosier Care Connect operation will be closed as part of this action.

The employment terminations are expected to commence on April 17, 2017. The number of workers who hold affected jobs in each job classification, the job titles of the affected positions, and schedule of separations are as shown on Schedule "A" which is attached and made a part of this notice.

This action is expected to be permanent in nature and there are no bumping rights for employees affected by this action. There is no union representative of the affected employees. 
