

**NOTICE OF FACILITY CLOSING**

This Notice is given pursuant to the Worker's Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN Notice).

MHP Pharmacy, LLC d/b/a Freedom Pharmacy of Indiana has been acquired by In Touch Pharmaceuticals, Inc. As a result of this acquisition, In Touch Pharmaceuticals, Inc. will close the former Freedom Pharmacy facility on October 31, 2010. You previously received a WARN Notice on June 2, 2010 which stated that the closing was expected to occur on August 2, 2010. Although the Company and the employees have worked diligently, there is still additional work to be performed in order to complete the facility closing. As a result, the facility will now be closed on October 31, 2010.

**DATE OF FACILITY CLOSING:**

The entire Indianapolis facility is scheduled to be permanently closed on October 31, 2010. The actual closing may occur any time within fourteen (14) days after October 31, 2010.
