

# Beyond the November 2014 Numbers...

## *Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report*

---

- Indiana's unemployment rate decline of 5.1% since July of 2009, the low point of employment in the state, ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has grown by more than 75,000 over the past year (+75,345), which ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in the nation in raw numbers added. Roughly 12,000 (+12,344) Hoosiers were added to the labor force in November alone, which ranked 11<sup>th</sup> in the US.
- The Hoosier State added 15,800 private sector jobs in November, the most in a one-month period in 15 years. This ranked as the 6<sup>th</sup> largest in the US.
- Since July 2009, Indiana has added 264,800 Private sector jobs, which ranks 9<sup>th</sup> in the nation, at a rate of 11.4%, which ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in the nation.
- Indiana added 2,300 Manufacturing jobs in November, which ranked 10<sup>th</sup> in the nation. The Hoosier State continues to lead the nation in Manufacturing job growth in 2014 (+24,900), and also leads the nation in rate of growth in 2014 (+5%).
- The Hoosier State has also added the 2<sup>nd</sup> most Manufacturing jobs (+94,700) in the U.S. since July 2009, at a rate that ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the nation (+22.1%).
- Indiana continues to have the highest concentration of private sector Manufacturing jobs in the U.S.
- Indiana's addition of 6,400 Professional & Business Services jobs in November ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the nation, at a rate of growth of 2%, also 3<sup>rd</sup> in the nation.
- The Hoosier state added 3,400 Trade, Transportation & Jobs in November, which ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in the nation.
- Indiana's growth of 1,900 Financial Activities jobs in November ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the nation, at a rate of 1.4%, which also ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the nation.
- **Indiana's Total Nonfarm employment (3,020,000) now exceeds the all-time peak of employment in March 2000 of 3,017,200.**
