

# Beyond the October 2014 Numbers...

## *Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report*

---

- Over the past year, Indiana's unemployment rate declined 1.4%, which is the 11<sup>th</sup> largest decrease in the nation. Indiana's decline of 5.1% since July of 2009, the low point of employment in the state, ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has grown by more than 65,000 over the past year (+65,366), which ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the nation in raw numbers added. Roughly 14,000 (+14,095) Hoosiers were added to the labor force in October alone, which ranked 9<sup>th</sup> in the US.
- Indiana added 2,500 Manufacturing jobs in October, which ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in the nation. The Hoosier State still leads the nation in Manufacturing job growth over the past year (+24,100), and is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the nation in rate of growth over the past year (+4.9%).
- The Hoosier State has also added the 2<sup>nd</sup> most Manufacturing jobs (+92,200) in the U.S. since July 2009, at a rate that ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in the nation (+21.5%).
- Indiana continues to have the highest concentration of private sector Manufacturing jobs in the U.S.
- Since July 2009, Indiana has added 247,500 Private sector jobs, which ranks 11<sup>th</sup> in the nation, at a rate of 10.4%, which ranks 9<sup>th</sup> in the nation.
- Indiana's growth of 3,300 Trade, Transportation & Utilities jobs (which includes retail) in October ranked 10<sup>th</sup> in the United States.
