Changing business needs require us to close this facility permanently and, therefore, we are providing you with this notice in accordance with requirements of the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Acts about the closing of this facility.

The Company officially will close its facility at 9901 Kincaid Drive on September 30th, 2018. More than sixty days notification was given to our workers on December 1, 2017 with the estimated first date of separation being January 31, 2018 with terminations expected to continue through September 30, 2018 as we wind down activities. There are 69 employees who will be affected by the 9901 Kincaid Drive facility closing. There are no applicable bumping rights.
