Dear Dislocated Worker Unit:

This letter constitutes notice pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act

Vibra Hospital of Fort Wayne, LLC ("Vibra Hospital") will be suspending service at the facility located at 2200 Randalia Drive, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46805, beginning immediately, and with intent to close the facility by January 31, 2019. The FEIN for Vibra Hospital is 90-0603597, and Vibra Hospital will be closed in its entirety.

Precise dates for completion of this closure, beyond what is stated above, are unavailable at this time, as Vibra Hospital will need to ensure appropriate transfer of any patients who cannot be discharged by January 31, 2019. This letter serves as advanced written notice that the employment of all employees at Vibra Hospital will be terminated due to this hospital's closure. The decision to close the hospital in its entirety is expected to be permanent.

There are no bumping rights associated with this closure, and there is no union representing employees at Vibra Hospital.
